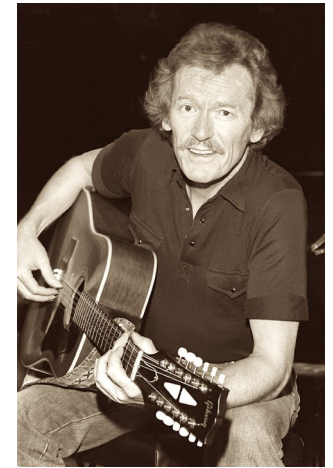


Producer's note:
