Job Description: Gardener's Assistant

Employment Type: Full-Time Seasonal 2019, 16 Weeks from April - August

R.J. Haney Heritage Village & Museum is a forty-acre heritage site located in Salmon Arm, BC. The facility is used by residents of Salmon Arm and area and tourists travelling to the area as a heritage tourist destination. We can promise you a memorable and gainful working experience as the Village Gardener's Assistant.

The successful candidate will assist the Gardener in the duties required to maintain the gardens and grounds of the 40 acre Heritage Village at a high standard. Duties include the care and maintenance of the ornamental plants, shrubs and trees on the property and in the heritage gardens within the Village. Duties also include removing the unwanted plants, trees and grass, remove the dead leaves. Watering the plants in the garden and planters through the Village and maintaining the pond and the footpaths. Operation of mechanical and power equipment is required while being health & safety conscious and maintaining a safe work environment. The job and the responsibility of the Gardener's Assistant can be changed according to the season. The ideal candidate should first and foremost enjoy physical, outdoor labour and have the ability to work alone or with a team. Flexible hours are sometimes required; therefore, the qualified candidate should be open to working early mornings or weekends.

Candidates should have strong communication skills and be energetic, out-going and punctual, and work well within a team environment. Provide excellent customer service to our visitors. Candidates should have an interest in horticultural and the desire to learn.

This is a full-time 16-week position from mid-May to the end of August, and you must be available to work evenings, weekdays and holidays. Candidates must be between the ages of 15 and 30, and be willing to commit to the full duration of the work dates and treat this as their primary job.

An alternate start date will be considered for students still in full-time studies until the end of June, or the end of their academic studies.
