Come and bid on pies specially baked and donated by pie contest winners from past years, and celebrity baked pies. Pies are auctioned to the highest bidder.

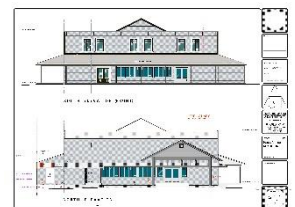

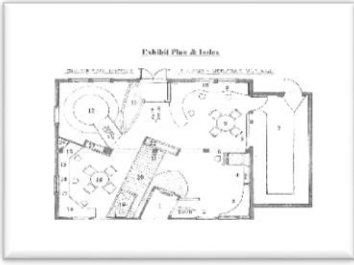

Last year the pie auction raised over a whopping \$43,000.00 towards the extraordinary projects at R.J. Haney Heritage Village & Museum. The Village & Museum are now raising funds for Phase 2/3, two very special projects, the Sprig of Heather Restaurant and the Children’s Discovery Centre.

Opening May 2020, the Sprig of Heather will be a quaint place to have lunch surrounded by the beautiful gardens and will be home to dinner service for Villains and Vittles Dinner Theatre and other events. The restaurant with a 40x40 pavilion is a versatile venue that can seat up to 150 guests making R.J. Haney Heritage Village the Shuswap’s favourite rustic venue for weddings, corporate and family gatherings.





The Children's Discovery Centre will provide hours of playful discovery for families focusing on key elements the Shuswap area has to offer. Water is a central theme to the two primary Cultures of the region, the Shuswap People and the early colonial settlers. And, the outdoor elements that offer opportunities to showcase the history of the land and cultures of the region from the distant past to the present. Children can

play in the Pilot House of the Steamboat, complete with ship's wheel and bell, or visit the Story Circle, a miniature version of the Shuswap 1st Nations Winter Home. There will be over 35 discovery drawers filled with puzzles, photo albums and artefacts for handling, and more. Binoculars to play a game of eye spy, a train table and interactive water table for play, and so much more. We guarantee that only your imagination will limit the amount of fun the Children's Discovery Center has to offer.

Donations from the pie auction receive a charitable tax receipt and go towards the construction of the Phase 2/3 Projects. Come as a single bidder or put together a bidding consortium and support this legacy full of family fun and entertainment for the whole Salmon Arm Community.

R.J. Haney Heritage Village is a not-for-profit charitable organization that proudly takes care of the history of Salmon Arm and the surrounding community. Located at 751-Highway 97B is a lovely place that offers an authentic experience for visitors to come and explore our rich heritage. The 40-acre site is comprised of 18 buildings that are either replicas or originals, including the original 1910 Haney House. There are over 30 exhibits, which tell the stories of Salmon Arm's history and the Shuswap, to discover on your next visit!



In 2017 the Village celebrated the grand opening of the Montebello Museum, the Village's Canada 150 Project. The Montebello Museum is over 12,000 square feet. Nine storefronts complete the stories told at the Village, such as Miss Puff's Millinery, the Salmon Arm Telephone Exchange, the McGuire

General Store and the newly opened E.A. Palmer Butcher Shop. It is the home for the Ernie Does Archives Room and the Museum's collection.

A must-see is our very popular Villains and Vittles Dinner Theatre Production. Enjoy a home-cooked meal and live theatre every Wednesday, Friday, and Sunday evening in July and August. Reservations are a must and seating is limited. You don't want to miss this highlight of Salmon Arm's summer entertainment!



If you are looking for a unique lunch experience, visit the Village's Sprig of Heather restaurant. Open from mid-May to mid-September, features a home-cooked \$9.99 daily lunch special and baked goodies.



Throughout the season, visitors also experience the many special events hosted by the Village with our community partners, including High Tea, Pioneer Day, the Classic Antique Car Show, Harvest Celebration, and more.
